



TOT TRAINING COURSE - MAURITIUS



Croplife Africa Middle East trainer, Mr Solofonirina Raberahona, conducted a five day Training of Trainers in Mauritius between 6 - 10 October 2008.

The training took place at the Regional Training Centre, in Reduit.
