

DANIDA

CropLife Uganda has concluded a contract with the "Agribusiness Development Component" (ABDC) on behalf of Danida's "Agricultural Sector Program Support" (ASPS) for the implementation of a programme termed "Decentralisation of Chemical Dealer Certification".

This programme is to conduct a ToT which when rolled out will certify all the dealerships affiliated to the "Uganda National Agro-Input Dealers Association" (UNADA).

A total of 30 candidates will undergo the designated training, 20 selected from UNADA representing the 10 regions and 10 from CropLife Uganda. The training comprises of a 10-day course of which the curriculum was developed by the Makerera University, Agricultural Faculty at Kabanyora. The training will run from 10 - 29 September.
