CONCLUSION

It is now critical that Stephen liaises with Mike Mailloux and Mark Wood on an action plan of planning further trainings (an exercise which is almost complete), and then for the trainers to report back to Mike and to Stephen, and onward to CropLife Africa Middle East (Les Hillowitz).

An excellent opportunity for CropLife to link with an important partner, USAID. This needs a lot of nurturing by CropLife Africa Middle East, East-Southern Hub.
